

1. What are the likely travel restrictions early in the season?

In England, we are awaiting more information in the announcement due on or around 22nd March, however the Government message is clear to Stay at Home until the 29th March. Sport England have produced some advice on travel which can be found <u>here</u>

In Wales, the Welsh Government requirement is to stay local, usually within 5 miles, but more information can be found <u>here</u>

2. When is the full guidance expected to be released and why is the Welsh guidance already in circulation?

As Wales has a devolved Government they have the responsibility to make decisions on the easing of lockdown restrictions in Wales. The Welsh Government is undertaking a review of the current Alert Level and restrictions on a three-weekly basis.

The UK Government have shared the roadmap to ease lockdown restrictions, the next update is expected on or around 22nd March, we will then review the implications and update our guidance accordingly, sharing more publicly as soon as we are comfortable in doing so.
